Regarding assistance in providing humanitarian aid

Dear Mr. Hetman!

Vinnytsia Regional Military Administration expresses its deep respect and appeals to you during the full-scale invasion of the Russian Federation into the territory of Ukraine and committing active military actions from Vinnytsia region to assist in the provision of humanitarian aid.

Our region is currently receiving refugees from other regions of Ukraine: Kyiv, Kharkiv, and Kherson. Today we have already received more than 10,000 civilians, including women, children and orphans. Vinnitsa region is becoming a military hospital for wounded civilians and soldiers from other regions.

Given these circumstances and in order to protect, provide medical assistance and meet the priority needs of the entire population, we ask for assistance to:

The personnel of the territorial defense units:

- autonomous generators
- 5, 000 bulletproof vest
- 5,000 thousand helmets
- 5,000 thousand knee pads, mittens
- · warm underwear, footwear, linen
- hats, gloves
- rations
- 5,000 individual first-aid kits

- 500 pcs. medical bags
- · Sleeping bags, sleeping mats, thermal blankets
- health care institutions to ensure uninterrupted operation of autonomous generators and medical supplies according to the Annex;
- population (single elderly people, families with persons with disabilities) and refugees of Vinnytsia region: long-term storage products (canned food, pasta, cereals), baby food, beds, blankets, thermal blankets, personal hygiene products;
- other humanitarian aid

The Armed Forces of Ukraine and the Ukrainian people are grateful to the Czech people and the Czech authorities for the military assistance already provided and for supporting the sovereignty and territorial integrity of Ukraine within its internationally recognized borders.

Your help is very important to us at this difficult time. We will be grateful for your help and will certainly report on its use!
